



# **The European Union**


- 28 countries



### **ASBESTOS REGULATION LANDMARKS**

#### A few landmarks

- Bans in some EU countries for 20-30 years
- EU regulation step by step
- European ban in 2003 with effect from 2005
  - extraction of asbestos
  - manufacture and processing of asbestos products
  - safer work conditions
- Still allowed to use asbestos in chlorine production
- Key EU regulation on Asbestos:
   DIR 2009/148
- The REACH Regulation


 Asbestos is the number one cause of death among occupational diseases in Europe European Commission 2009/2012


# **ASBESTOS FREE WORLD OF WORK?**

- Workers, owners, tenants and users are potentially exposed


# Main challenge



# **Major landmark in Europe**


- Initiative Report adopted 14 March 2013

- World wide ban of asbestos




