






"Europe 2023 – Asbestos free" We are still surrounded by asbestos




Initiative Report of the EP

- Presentation of the draft at 8 October 2012 in the Employment Committee – 36 suggestions
- On 14 March with vast majority adopted
- Addressee: European Commission
- ✤ Available in all languages
- How the Commission will react?

 - World wid ban of asbestos





- An initaitive for a world wide ban



Initiative report of the European Parliament

Restructuring programme

- A coordinated asbestos-programme in the new community strategy on workplance safety (16)
- Action plans on European, natinal and regional levels are demanded (24)
- Enhanced market surveillance (18)
- Better application of the existing asbestos directives – via SLIC (14)
- Modification of the effective derogations from the ban (17)

Initiative report of the European Parliament

Suggestions

- A model for the screening of asbestos (1,2)
- Combination of programmes for energy efficiency of buildings and the removal of asbestos (4,5)
- A specific directive for the qualification of workers (10)
- Training for labour inspectors (11)
- Harmonisation of proceedings for the recognition and compensation (19,21,23) – Reversal of evidence (24)
